### **Legends Bless their Children**

Father's Day started in 1909 when a young lady by the name of **Sonora Smart Dodd**, who was at church on Mother's Day, when she listened to the sermon and she thought about how they were celebrating the life of her Mother.

According to the story, Sonora's mother had died in childbirth, and her father, **Henry Jackson Smart**, a Civil War veteran and farmer, was raising Sonora and her five siblings as a single parent. Sonora wanted to find a way to celebrate and thank her Dad with a day that was as special to Mother's, to honor her Father and his sacrifices for their family.

It wasn't until 1924, when U.S. President **Calvin Coolidge** officially urged Americans to celebrate a national **Father's Day**. By 1966, President Lyndon B. Johnson signed a Presidential Proclamation, designating the third Sunday of June as **Father's Day**. President **Richard M. Nixon** signed a 1972 bill, making the holiday legal, official and permanent.

In 1999, Father's Day became the fifth most popular card-sending holiday, with an estimated \$95 million in card
