Sin Smoke and Blood Romans 12

Intro:

Our minds are the ground the word of God is planted into. Our mind is the filter that gives access to the Spirit Soul and Body. Jesus compared the word of God to a seed. Our minds are compared to a field. We determine what happens to the seed. Will we hear the word of God today and let it bounce off our hardened mind and let demons carry it away? Will we embrace the word and let it grow quickly but never remove the rocky ground in our lives that will choke it out? Will we allow other seeds that aren't the truth grow alongside the word of God and choke it out? Or, will we break up the ground and remove the other weeds so that the seed of the word of God can grow and produce a harvest of 100 times greater? The choice is up to you! Guard your hearts and minds. Watch what goes into your mind. The thoughts that you allow in and the thoughts you allow to grow will determine who you become.

Romans 12:1

Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God - this is your spiritual act of worship.

Titus 3:5-7 he saved us, not because of righteous things we have done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior.

So that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

1 Co 6:19-20 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Romans 12:2

Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - his good, pleasing and perfect will.

1 John 2:15-17 Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For everything in the world - the cravings of the sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does - comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass.

Ephesians 4:22-24 You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires: to be made new in attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

Ephesians 5:25 -27 Husbands, love your wife's, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.

Romans 12:3

For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgement, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you.

James 4:10 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

Ephesians 4:2-3 Be completely humble and gentle: be patient, bearing with one another in love Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

Psalms 51:16-17 You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.
